







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Planned programme learning intentions for children



- Children will have opportunities to reconnect with friends and make new friends.
- Children to be apart of the decision making of their learning; understanding and setting boundaries for the setting.
- Children will have opportunities to take risks and build on skills whilst moving in a range of ways and with equipment.
- Children will experiment new ways of putting food together in a simple form.
- Children to create a variety of patterns and shape using colour and a range of media and tools.
- Children to work collaboratively to trail and see history in action at museums.
- Children to take part in stories through action story telling and recreating it for themselves podcasting, blogging and Vlogging.
- Trip to 3 Movie making etc IT – using tablet computers to create movies from storyboarding through to filming and editing. **The move making session involves the children taking pictures of themselves for this, so if there are children who cannot have pictures taken please let us know.**
- Children to demonstrate and take responsibility for their own actions, supporting their interests and needs
- Children to share their interests in movies of their own choice with peers.
- Children to have opportunities to create and personalise meaningful objects for themselves.
- Garage Band – music making session for budding musicians
